Dear parent/carer,

We continue to help you as much as we can, particularly during the challenges that the pandemic presents. We are pleased to let you know that we have put in place **free holiday clubs and activities over the Summer holidays** through our Happy Healthy Active Holidays scheme.

The scheme provides a range of enjoyable activities and healthy meals, and is being delivered in partnership with local community organisations. There are a range of holiday clubs offering free places for primary and secondary school-aged children eligible for benefits related free school meals across Telford & Wrekin. However, places are limited and we expect demand to be high, so **we recommend booking early** to avoid disappointment. Children can attend up to 16 holiday club sessions over the Summer holidays, at no cost to you. Sessions vary in length, but most are for 4 hours a day. The sessions will include a variety of fun activities, such as sports, music or arts and craft, along with a free nutritious meal each day. There is specific provision for children with SEND or additional needs.

We are also offering a number of free family activity sessions during August, including ice skating, footgolf, and cycling. Children will need to be accompanied by a parent or carer for these sessions, however the activity will be free for the whole family. All school-aged children attending these sessions will also get a free healthy packed lunch to take home. We also have a number of activities for unaccompanied 14-16 year olds to enjoy.
