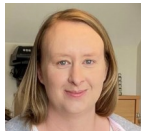
## Back-To-School Success!

## Intervention Spotlight



At Newdale, we use Read Write Inc Phonics (RWI) to give your child the best start with their Literacy development. RWI helps **all** children learn to read fluently and at speed so they can focus on developing their skills in comprehension, vocabulary, and spelling. RWI is a daily intervention, bespoke to every child’s individual needs. Children are assessed at least every 5 weeks to ensure they are making progress and to allow for personal gaps to be addressed.

**We strongly encourage regular reading at home to further support your child’s progress.**



## Parents Opening Doors (PODS)

PODS is a parent carer/peer led charity who have the relevant ‘real life’ experience to support families who have a child with a disability or additional need. Parent participation is at its heart as parent carers can pinpoint problems frequently experienced by families with disabled children.

# Setting Routines



At Newdale, we recognise the significance of routine and consistency in providing a sense of security for all our pupils. As parents, you play a crucial role in establishing these routines.

## Morning Routines:

A well-planned morning can set the tone for the rest of the day. This can include waking up, getting dressed, brushing teeth, eating breakfast, and preparing for school. Depending on your child's needs, it might be beneficial to add in a short activity to help them wake up.

## After-School Routines:

Homework, playtime and organised activities. Be sure to incorporate breaks as well. A consistent after-school routine is equally important. Allocate time for a snack and relaxation too.

## Bedtime Routines:

Establishing a calming bedtime routine can significantly help your child wind down and get a good night's sleep. This could include activities like taking a bath, brushing teeth and reading.

## Visual Schedules:

Visual schedules can be particularly effective in helping children with SEND understand and follow routines. They provide a clear, visual representation of what to expect, reducing anxiety and improving independence.
