Successes

- Swim England Awards are now embedded which means that learning can easily be picked up where it has been left in the previous year group. E.g. Joe Bloggs completed grade 4 in Year 5 and can therefore move on to the grade 5 award in Year 6.
- All children (including non-swimmers) can achieve an award using the Swim England awards. There are also foundation awards that are tailored to SEND needs.
- Sam Morrow has been fantastic and consistent across all lessons.
- Subject lead is now also a level 2 trained swimming teacher so she can also attend should Sam not be available.
- CPD given to all key stage 2 teachers during the first week back of the year by the subject lead. Sharing of ideas, expectations, a recap of assessment standards etc.

Assessment

Year 6 assessments

All children completed at least the first 3 grades in the Swim England Awards.

82% of pupils could swim the expected 25metres using a recognisable stroke.

All children completed class based water safety lessons and all children experienced wearing clothing in the pool and trying to swim/complete challenges.
