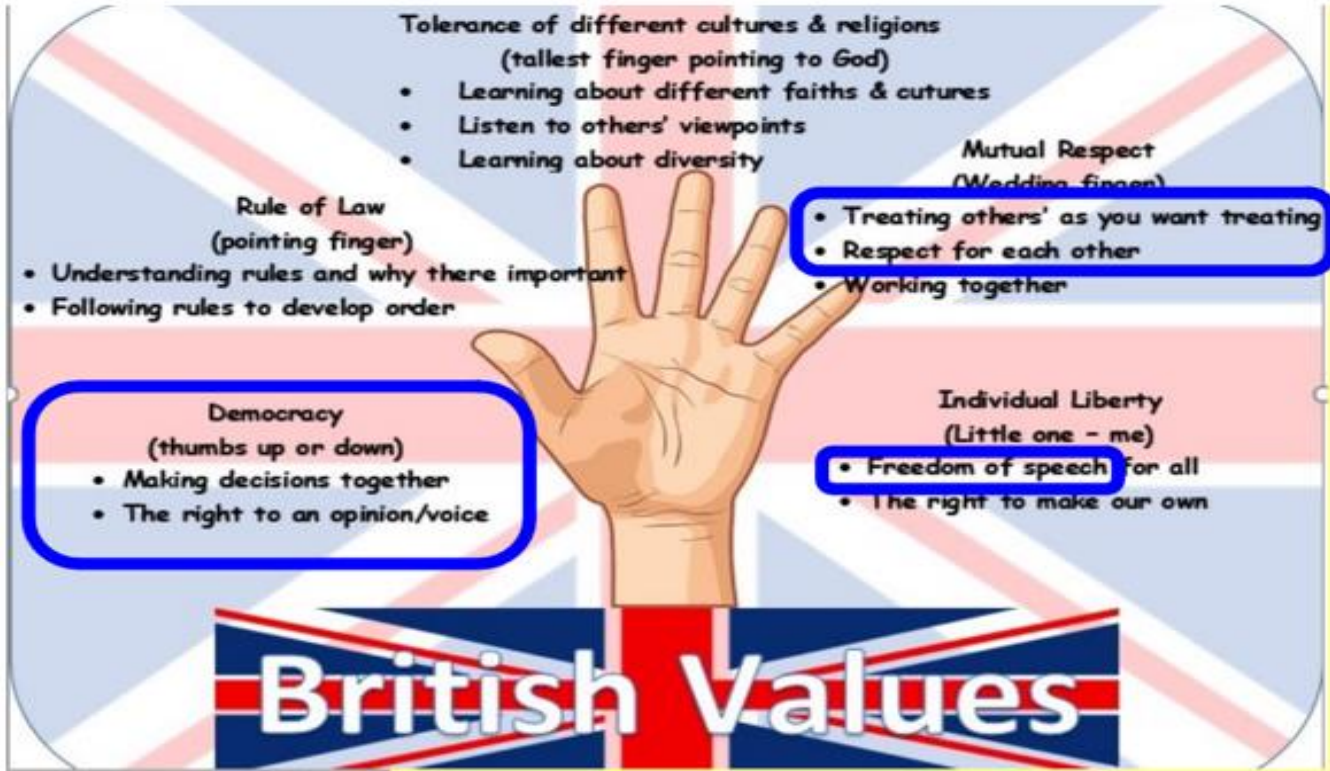


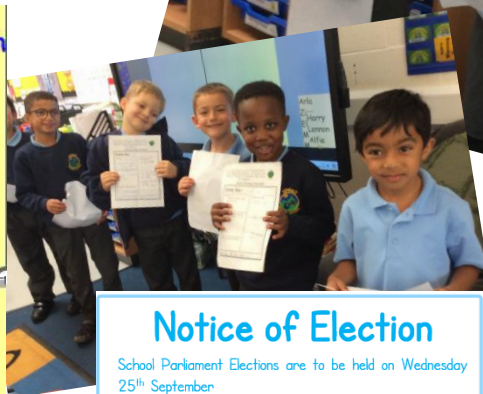
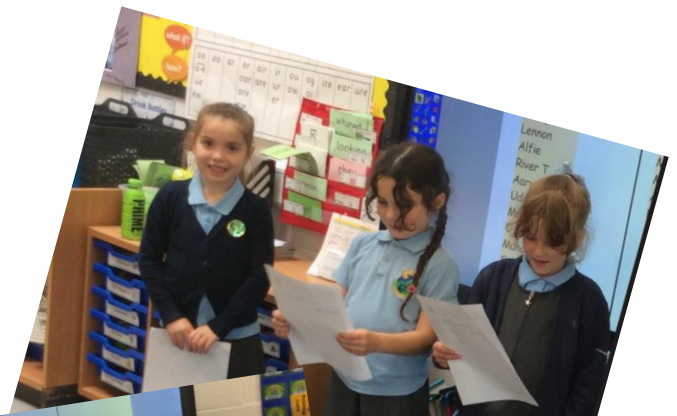
British Values Week
